Aid and Attendance

Veterans and their surviving spouses who are eligible for a VA pension and require the aid and attendance of another person, or are housebound, may be eligible for additional monetary payment to help cover the costs of care. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has established qualification criteria for veterans and/or their surviving spouses for the Aid and Attendance Pension benefit:

- Veteran or Surviving Spouse of a veteran who served 90 days or more on active duty, with at least one day of service during a period of war.
- Applicant must have a medical condition not related to military service requiring assistance with activities of daily living.
- Veteran must have an honorable discharge.
- Meet income-to-medical expense ratio.
- Must meet asset requirements. Excluding home and 1 vehicle, assets must total \$150,538 or less.

VA's Homemaker and Home Health Aide Program

This program is designed for Veterans who require skilled services, case management, and assistance with daily activities. It's also available for Veterans who are isolated or whose caregivers are under strain.

Homemaker and Home Health Aide services can complement other Home and Community Based Services, with availability varying by location. They offer an alternative to nursing home care and can provide Respite Care at home for Veterans and their family caregivers. These services support Veterans' of any age to continue living in their own homes.

As part of the VHA Standard Medical Benefits Package, enrolled Veterans are eligible for Homemaker and Home Health Aide services **if they meet the clinical need.**

A copay may apply based on your VA service-connected disability status.
